

Good eyesight helps us to avoid many obstacles that may hurt us or slow us down. Good eyesight helps us find the things we are looking for. Good eyesight makes sure that we arrive where we intended to go.

All of these truths about physical eyesight are also true for a church which has healthy vision. A healthy vision helps a church avoid obstacles, find what it is looking for, and arrive where it needs to go.
